


FEBRUARY MEETING IS A FIELD TRIP














BUILDING A BLUEBIRD HOUSE CLASS

The Bluebird House class was taught by Mark Voigt on January 16 and 17th. The students not only completed a Bluebird House on the first night but then also constructed a Wren House on night two. In addition to the two nice bird houses, Mark covered shop and equipment safety and equipment operation.









MAKING A KUMIKO PANEL

January 24 and 25 were the days that eight students attended the Kumiko panel class. It was taught by Wayne Peterson from Kansas City.

The main class project was making a panel made in the Asanoha pattern. Many students were able to finish and then start a second pattern.

The panels are all made of basswood. As a result of this class the club now owns all the jigs for cutting the Kumiko pieces!











BUILDING A PICTURE FRAME

Tim DuBois and Don Peterson taught a picture frame class February 8 and 9. Five students completed a maple and cherry frame approximately 18 inches by 15 inches. The frames were sized to hold a mated 8 X10 piece of art. The class covered shop and table saw safety and table saw operation.

9 a.m.-4 p.m.






A hands-on experience taking a live edge slab and transforming it into a well-designed, beautiful bench with a waterfall mitered leg and inlayed bow ties. Students will use the Festool track saw and Domino, as well as standard tools like table saws and routers.

The finished bench is about 30"L x 10-14"W x 18"H

Cost: registration \$250; plus estimated materials fee of at least \$100 to be paid to instructor.

No previous experience necessary.




THE JOY OF WOODWORKING WITH MARK VOIGT






