- 2. Discipline be safe every time
- 3. Time for Safety set ups
- 4. Responsibility own safe attitudes
- 5. Avoid Risks what could happen

# PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- Safety glasses
- Hearing and dust protection recommended
- Participants provide PPE

### SAFETY OBSERVATIONS

- Be pro-active broadens safety attitudes
- Every member responsible for safety
- Ongoing, two-way safety discussions
  - Provide positive and constructive feedback to one another
- Shop Foreman on-scene safety compliance official

#### **TAKE AWAYS**

#### I. Safe attitudes result in safe behaviors

- Always observe the 3" rule
- Become familiar with the machine or tool before using it
- Improving safe behaviors is not limited to the novice
- Safety is for power tools and hand tools
- Take a break when tired or impaired
- Clean up after yourself
- Shop Foreman is on-scene safety official
