Renew your Membership Dues

It is that time of year again. Please pay your 2011 dues (\$30) at the January or February meeting, or send them to the CMWA address above.

If I install a central dust collector, would you recommend I install it in my heated and well insulated shop or in the attached, unheated garage?

A dust collector moves a lot of air, and in the middle of a Minnesota winter that will be a lot of heated air. A collector installed outside the shop in your unheated garage, will simply move a lot of heat from your shop to your unheated garage, an expensive proposition. If you install the collector inside your shop, you will keep that heat in your shop but you also have to put up with the noise and loss of space. A good compromise, especially with a cyclone type collector, is to place the

collector outside the heated shop but route the exhaust air back into the shop saving all that precious heat. If the collector is a bag type, you can always build a small room to house the collector and bags and provide access ports for the air to move back into the heated workshop. With either system, some means of remote monitoring of the dust level in the collection drum or bag is necessary. Oneida's new Dust Sentry uses infrared sensing technology combined with a bright strobe light for monitoring sawdust levels in drums (available for \$129.00 from www.oneida-air.com). With a bit of ingenuity, the Dust Sentry could be adapted for bag type collectors too.




